## **Terms and Responsibilities:**

- 1. The term of the Chairperson and members shall be for a period of two years.
- 2. The term of the Special Invitee shall be one year.
- 3. The quorum for the meeting, including the Chairperson but excluding the Special Invitee, shall be three.
- 4. In considering grievances before it, the SGRC shall follow the principles of natural justice.
- 5. The SGRC shall send its report with recommendations, if any, to the competent authority of the institution concerned and provide a copy to the aggrieved student, preferably within a period of 15 working days from the date of receipt of the complaint.
- 6. Any student aggrieved by the decision of the SGRC may prefer an appeal to the Ombudsperson within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of such a decision.
