1.2 Revolutionary Physics Experiments that shaped our World - An Introduction to Iconic Experiment Setups






The activity encouraged brainstorming, open discussion, and idea sharing among students. The students presented innovative solutions to complex problems and fostered a collaborative and supportive environment.


5.3 Quiz

An expert talk on 'Gender Sensitization' was organized for the newly admitted students during the Orientation Programme on July 28, 2023.





- The examination process was explained starting from course registration, question paper setting, evaluations of various components of a course (theory, tutorials, and practicals), the re-evaluation process to rules for promotion to higher semester.
- University Grading System: The later Grading System with UGC-prescribed rules has been explained. The process of calculation with regulations has been explained.
- The method of calculating CPA and CGPA through a table and examples were explained. The common terms used on the grade card and progression was explained i.e., grade points, GPA, CGPA, etc.
- Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP): Briefly explain the major features of the SPSU ERP system with a live demonstration and screenshots. All-important features of ERP for a student have been explained, i.e., Fee, Update Information, Course/Subject





Registration, Timetable, Daily and Monthly Attendance, Library, Mess, Hostel (Attendance, Out Pass, etc.), Results, Academic Calendar, Feedback, etc.

The students were instructed to download the ERP app (G5 My Connect) and log in with their SPSU credentials that gave them a fair idea of the system.

7.7 IT Services

8.1 Each One Plant One in collaboration with My FM







The psychometric profiling for the new students was held on 4th August 2023. In the pursuit of understanding the psychological and emotional well-being of students, a comprehensive session was conducted to profile student optimism levels. This endeavor utilized the Optimism Index 1.1 questionnaire, designed by Prof. (Dr.) Padmakali Banerjee, Honorable Vice-Chancellor and President SPSU. Dr. Bhavana Adhikari, Dean Academics and Ms. Sanchita Ghosh conducted the test.

The session engaged a diverse cohort of students, representing various academic backgrounds and stages. The profiling revealed a spectrum of optimism levels among the student body, ranging from highly optimistic to moderately optimistic and even a subset displaying lower levels of optimism. An analysis of the responses pointed towards several factors influencing students' optimism. These included personal experiences, family support, academic achievements, and perceptions of control over their own lives. It was observed that students with higher optimism scores tended to employ healthier coping

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mechanisms when faced with challenges. They exhibited a greater propensity to seek social support, engage in problem-solving, and maintain a growth-oriented mindset. Students with higher optimism scores tended to exhibit better resilience during setbacks, translating to improved performance across various academic pursuits. Students who reported higher academic achievement displayed greater levels of optimism. Another intriguing insight was the link between peer relationships and optimism. Students who reported a strong support network of friends showcased higher optimism levels. The students enjoyed the engaging and informative session.


